

- Lunch room supervision if you can call it that, a mean adult who clearly doesn't want to there. I pay for that. A classroom of non English speaking kids, I pay for that. I pay for those kids to have a TA while my child can't get basic assistance with Math or grammar or spelling!! You are failing our children. Now more than ever parents are pulling their children to homeschool them because despite having resources our children are falling behind. I pay for that. I don't believe anything I say here will make an ounce of difference. Surveys give the impression of listening or valuing our option which you clearly don't.
- Having an idea of the fees for the year in September can help a family plan!
- The lunch supervision fee is unreasonable. My son never eats his food. I don't understand why I pay for it.
- The noon supervision fees are a waste of money. We have been told by our children that they do not feel comfortable telling the supervisor of problems. Also, on colder days, children who are dressed appropriately should be able to get outside and play. As Canadians, we need to encourage our youth to understand how to dress properly for colder temperatures. If there are children who do not come to school prepared, then they can stay inside.
- The government should be supporting education more so that eventually the funds needed will be able to support the school fully. I'm all for paying fees if it helps provide more to the students. I support all education workers in the fight for what's right.
